What Not to Bring

For guys and girls, no immodest clothing. This includes see-through, tight-fitting, or low-cut clothing (such as leggings, spaghetti strap tank tops, and short shorts).

NO Electronic Devices / phones, tablets, music players, game systems, etc.

NO Alcohol, Drugs, or Tabaco Products / including all nicotine products like vapes, juul's, cigarettes, etc.

NO Weapons | firearms, bows or throwing, batons, knives, stun guns, fighting weapons (metal knuckles, chuka

sticks, sandclubs), bombs, fireworks (pyrotechnics), homemade weapons (potato guns, chemical based weapons),

ammunition, or replica, antique, training, or toy versions of any of the above.

NO Books/Magazines other than Bibles and Christian Devotionals

Should any of these items be brought to camp, they will be confiscated and held in the Camp Office
