

Pursuit Covid-19 Communication

January 5, 2021

Pursuit Guidelines:

1. When unable to Social Distance masks need to be worn.
2. Word of Life has the theme during this pandemic of “protecting one another, by preferring one another.” Therefore, the following guidelines will be in place, updates will be communicated:
 - a. Prior to Arrival – Three days of temperatures and symptoms being monitored by parents/ guardians and communicated to Youth leaders to ensure that the health and well-being for the individual and others is being followed.
 - b. This sheet needs to be ready at station #1 when you arrive for a smooth registration process.
 - c. Arrival:
 - i. Temp checks done as well as Health Screening at a separate location than Registration.
 - ii. Anyone camper who temps 100.3 degrees or above will be asked to wait 20 min and be re-temp'd. If the camper has a temp over 100.3 degrees, they will not be allowed to attend camp.
 - iii. If a Camper has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days a negative test (with paperwork), or a positive for anti-bodies, will be required for them to attend Pursuit Camp.
 - iv. If a Camper has been around someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 within a 6-foot distance and without wearing a mask, will be asked not to attend Pursuit Camp.
 1. Should they have a negative test for Covid since the event, or a positive for anti-bodies, then the Camper will be allowed to attend Pursuit Camp.
 - v. If a Camper is coming from a “Hot Spot” area, defined as a county that has a positivity rate over 10%, the Camper may be asked to not attend Pursuit Camp.
 - d. Registration at the BPAC:
 - i. Hand sanitization when entering Registration
 - ii. Face masks need to be worn while in the Registration building
 - iii. Please, no physical contact.
 - e. While at Pursuit:
 - i. Temps taken Saturday and Sunday morning.
 - ii. Meetings:
 1. Hands Sanitized before entering Meetings.
 2. Seating will be by Cabin and 6ft apart from other Cabins.
 3. Meeting rooms will be cleaned and disinfected after every meeting
 - iii. Meals:
 1. Hands Sanitize before entering dining hall
 2. Meals served family style.
 3. Dining hall is disinfected after every meal.
 - iv. Games geared toward health and safety.
 - v. Health Center available for concerns and health and safety.
 - f. When Leaving:
 - i. Temps will be taken of all campers that morning to ensure that symptoms were not present when they left Word of Life Pursuit Camp.
 - ii. Cabins will be cleaned and disinfected using the approved CDC chemicals in preparation for the next use.
3. After Pursuit Camp notification procedures when contacted about a case:
 - a. Fellow Cabin mates will be notified if one from their cabin has tested positive and allow parent (or, guardian)/ church to take care of that child's needs.
 - b. Word of Life will follow protocols for the care and well-being of the counselors.
